Thank you for your interest in CTC's Summer School 2021.

Even if you have taken part in our Summer Schools before, we politely request that you read this pack very carefully as there are changes from previous years.

We have run two successful Summer Schools in previous years but, moving forward, we will be focusing on show material from Bugsy Malone.

Participants must be at least 9 and no older than 18 years of age on Sunday 25 July 2021.

Proof of ID may be requested. Unfortunately, we are unable to make any exceptions to these age restrictions.

The Summer School aims to bring 45 young people together in a friendly environment where they will get to explore storytelling through acting, singing and dancing with the focus being on Bugsy Malone where we aim to run a short showcase on the final day for parents.



OFFICIAL OVERVIEW

Bugsy Malone is set in Prohibition era New York with rival gangsters Fat Sam and Dandy Dan at logger heads.

As custard pies fly and Dan's destructive 'splurge guns' wreak havoc, Bugsy Malone, a penniless ex-boxer and all round nice guy, falls for Blousey Brown, an aspiring singer.

Will Bugsy be able to resist the advances of seductive songstress Tallulah, Fat Sam's moll and Bugsy's old flame, and stay out of trouble, while helping Fat Sam to defend his business?

During the most recent London revival of Bugsy Malone in 2015, The Independent aptly described the show, calling it a "gangster musical that reveals the childishness of adults and the maturity of children". For those who have seen the 1976 film version starring Jodie Foster, you will remember it as the gangster film entirely performed by children, lip syncing to songs sung by adults. The stage version is much the same except that the young people sing the songs themselves. The show highlights the impact caused by gang culture and gun violence in prohibition era America, and using kids…and splurge, is a vehicle to highlight the absurdity of that situation and yet still acknowledge the shock and chaos it created.

This year's summer school is in a slightly different format, instead of a full scale production, the showcase will be stripped down, which will allow us to spend more time delving into character, choreography, story and music. The students of the summer school this year will work hard to create an honest, humorous re-telling of this classic to family and friends at the end of week showcase and we can't wait to get started.

WORKSHOP DAY

MEMBERSHIP FEE

£195 per participant for CTC Youth Member.

£250 per participant for Non Member

The membership fee does not include meals or transportation, which remain the responsibility of the parents/guardians.

FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE

This year we are introducing two payment schedule options:

Option 1

> Payment of £100 to secure your place

Option 2

> The remaining £95 to be paid by Friday 6 August 2021, if your child has attended in person classes. In the event of us not being able to run the summer school in person, we will go to an online model where there will be a reduction in cost.

This means in securing your place you accept the conditions if we have to move the course online.

Failure to pay by the deadlines will result in the participant not being allowed to audition for participation in future projects. If a participant decides to withdraw from the project, the fee is nonrefundable.
