DIRECTOR'S VISION CONTINUED....

We made this decision because many of the original cast have moved on to universities, left to live in different countries or taken on other opportunities which meant they were no longer able to do the show. We are sad that it worked out that way but we very much hope to see many of the original performers back to be in the show again.

The belly-laugh jokes are still there (and more!), but the addition of the songs adds a whole new dimension - allowing us to connect on a deeper level and see the characters' vulnerabilities laid bare. Shrek is so much more than just a big, fat ogre; he's this amazing being, with hopes and dreams just like any other protagonist and I want to further explore his quirks and humility in this production.

There is something for everyone; a feisty female role model proving princesses can be strong and independent, the hilarious side-kick donkey dishing out the comedy from all angles and, of course, the ensemble fairytale characters who bring so much heart to the show, which would be poorer without them. There are so many featured ensemble roles that it will really give the performers a chance to play around and try out a range of acting styles.

Of course, Lord Farquaad, at only 3 foot tall, injects humour in the form of the hopeless villain and will require some very tricky and precise acting, being on his knees for the entire show...

We can't wait to finally unleash the world of Duloc upon Cambridge, so make sure you come along to finally live Happily Ever After.

HOW TO BOOK AN AUDITION

To request an audition slot, email us at auditions@camtheatrecompany.co.uk

Mention your preferred audition session and whether you wish to audition for Young Shrek, Young Fiona or the Children's Ensemble.

Applicants must be at least 9 and no older than 13 years of age at the time of the audition. Regrettably, we are unable to make any exceptions to these age restrictions.

FORMAT OF AUDITIONS

Once everyone is signed in, the members of the creative team will introduce themselves and explain how the workshop will be run. Applicants do not need to prepare anything for the audition workshop. Applicants will be taught a verse and chorus of a Shrek song and a short dance piece on the day. It's important to highlight that we don't just expect the 'best' singers, dancers and actors; we like to recognise potential and work with individuals throughout the process.

CTC will not take any responsibility for personal belongings that may get lost.

Parents/Guardians wishing to stay and wait for their children may wait in the waiting area but will not be allowed to watch the audition workshop.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE

A full rehearsal schedule will be sent out about 4 weeks before the first rehearsal. It's important to give us any dates for which you will be unavailable. Please indicate these on the audition form, which you'll hand in at your audition. This will assist us with preparing the rehearsal schedule.

The first rehearsal for Shrek will be on Sunday 10th April and, from then, every Tuesday and Friday evening until the show, with rehearsals on alternate Sundays.

SHOW TEAMS

There will be two teams of children alternating performances. The full breakdown will be given in February 2022 ahead of the tickets going on sale.

PARTICIPATION FEE

In Cambridge many groups charge a production fee to assist with costs for the production. This will be £175 for Shrek and you will be provided with a show t-shirt.

The membership fee is per project and will be eligible for the Gift Aid scheme since we are now a registered charity. This means we will be able to secure 25p for each £1 paid to support Cambridge Theatre Company. If you are successful on the project, then we will forward you a Gift Aid declaration which we very much hope you will complete.

COSTUMES AND PROPS

Although we will provide costumes, participants will be asked to provide some basic elements of their costume that can hopefully be found easily at home or from a charity shop etc.

ACCEPTANCE OF YOUR AUDITON OFFER

If you are successful at audition, in order to secure your place you will need to pay your membership fee ahead of us announcing the full casting. You will be required to pay £100 to secure your place and the remaining £75 by the date of the first rehearsal in April.

If you decide to withdraw from the project, the membership fee is non-refundable. Failure to pay by the deadline above will result in the applicant being excluded from the project.

NOTE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS

We rely on good communication and punctual timekeeping with Parents/Guardians to ensure that the project runs smoothly. With this in mind, we have introduced a Code of Conduct for all performers to ensure that the company procedures are always being met. The code of conduct will be sent out with the casting offer email.
